- support for the active involvement of young workers or students of PhD study programs in research teams of national and international projects of science, research and innovation, in the activities of national and international working groups, organizations;
- media coverage and other forms of support for emphasizing the societal national and international importance of technical professions not only in the railway sector, support for societal discussion on this topic
